Pamphlet Rack

All the material for the pamphlet rack have been procured and are on site. The Rink Staff will coordinate with the Township to schedule the installation of the pamphlet rack. The Rink Staff will communicate with each of the resident clubs to let them know when they can use the pamphlet rack for their printed materials.

Electronic locker assignment board

A new monitor has been purchase and is awaiting installation. It was discovered that the display cannot be mounted on the PoS office as anticipated. The new monitor will be installed in the location of the existing dry marker board. A protective piece of Plexiglas (Lexan) will be installed over the display to protect against damage.

Advertising on the Boards

All the old, outdated, and damaged advertisement decals have been removed from the boards. The Rink Staff started a campaign to contact existing advertisers and reached out to some perspective advertisers to update the decals on the boards. Significant progress has been made to renew existing advertisers and the number is expected to increase. There has also been an uptick in new advertisers.
