Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis Available for Public Comment

HAVERTOWN PCP SUPERFUND SITE

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has developed an Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) for a Non-Time Critical Removal Action at the Havertown PCP Site. The purpose of this EE/CA is to evaluate alternatives for treating contaminated groundwater that is collected at the Site. A temporary groundwater treatment system (TGTS) is currently operating to treat contaminated groundwater that is collected by a series of groundwater recovery points east of N. Eagle Road.

EPA's preferred alternative described in the EE/CA is Alternative #3. Alternative #3 includes:

- Construction of a new permanent GWTP at 900 North Eagle Road with capacity to treat at least 175 gallons of groundwater per minute.
- Install up to eight additional deep groundwater recovery wells to capture high level contamination and the dissolved plume at depths up to 400 feet below the surface.
- Dismantle the TGTS once the new GWTP is operational; and,
- Continue long term operation, maintenance, and monitoring of the new GWTP and groundwater contamination.

EPA is seeking your input during the 30-day public comment period. Both the EE/CA and the Administrative Record, which contains documents that provide information considered during EE/CA process, are available for public review. Upon completion of the comment period, EPA will evaluate comments and issue the final selected alternative for groundwater treatment in an Action Memorandum (AM). The AM will include EPA responses to public comments received during the comment period. Details on how to review the EE/CA and submit comments are as follows:
