Thank you for your interest in our Leaders in Training (L.I.T.) Program. The L.I.T. Program is for Haverford Township residents ages 14-15 or entering grades 9 or 10. Please complete and return the application below **no later than Friday, May 14** to the Recreation Dept. at 9000 Parkview Dr. Haverford, Pa 19041 or via email to Jhart@havtwp.org.

Overview of program; please read carefully:

Program requirements:

- L.I.T.'s must have **completed 8th grade** by summer 2021.
- You **must** be a resident of Haverford Township to apply.
- You must be available for a minimum of three consecutive weeks between June 28 and August 6.
- L.I.T.'s must re-apply every year.

About the program:

- L.I.T.'s are assigned 12-15 hours per week for a minimum of three weeks at a Township camp location. Most assignments are Monday-Thursday. You may be asked to work on Friday.
- L.I.T.'s are NOT paid; this is a leadership training program.

Important dates:

- There are a limited number of spots available for this program and all applicants are interviewed. **Interviews will take place Monday, May 17 and Monday, May 24 from 6-7:30pm at the CREC*.** *See page 2 to select your interview date. Please come dressed in athletic attire.*
- All applicants will be contacted via email by June 11 to notify them if they are accepted. If you are accepted into the program, we cannot guarantee that you will be placed close to home.
- Accepted applicants are required to attend a training session on Tuesday, June 22 at the CREC* – times TBD.

*We may decide to switch these to virtual events. We will notify you closer to the dates if there are changes.
