Monthly Update from Alexis De Santi, Haverford Township Special Projects Coordinator
The Havagood times due the end of the month for summer events. Budget, 20,500 approved for 2025. Earth day event – planting at CREC, are we interested in funding the plants?

Presentation by two students from Penn State University's Local Climate Action Program will present the results of their study of Haverford Township's Greenhouse Gas Inventory

17.8% reduction in GHG emissions from 2015 to 2023 for township

Question about how much of the reduction is from the grid mix change – they will follow up

Question about the utility mix inclusive of RECs being transacted – not captured in data

Q: CAP 2021: Did we have a GHG inventory? They only see the 2015 one

Q: For the clearpath analysis, what is the uncertainty? The bigger sectors have better data, the natural gas was estimated. Imprecise tool at best.

Q: Could the township approach the NG supplier to ask for usage? The DEP office made the request and they didn't provide. Maybe the Muni request would work better.
ACT129

Q: There is a 400% increase in the charge for capacity proposed by PJM. Heat pump conversions will be captured in the data, the solar you do not see in the data. We could manually include the solar if we can provide the data. Others think solar is captured.

Q: Is clearpath open source? No, but was free to htown this year.
